



## **The Transitions House Resident Agreement**

Resident requirements for students living at the Transitions House:

1. Must be 18-20 years old. Exceptions may be made for older students when their Directors sign approving documentation.
2. Regularly attend school and Transitions events (meetings at school and other activities) and passing all classes.
3. Skipping school is not acceptable.
4. A student may stay home from school if House Director notes illness. While at home and after school hours, the student may watch TV and use cell phone.
5. If a student is sent home from school sick, a note from the school nurse must accompany them.
6. All missed schoolwork from sick days must be caught up within one week.
7. Abstain from alcohol and other drugs; agree to random drug testing at any time.
8. No alcohol is permitted on premises.
9. No gun, knives, or other weapons of any kind are permitted on premises.
10. Abstain from sexual activity at the Transitions House.
11. Respect others in the Transitions House.
12. Respect the Transitions House as a non-smoking, no pet residence. Smoking is permitted outside, and butts must be placed in provided receptacle.
13. Keep the living area clean and help with rotating chores (in & outside)
14. Keep bedroom clean and neat.
15. Follow personal hygiene routines
16. Curfew is 10:00 p.m. week days (unless working) and 1:00 a.m. weekends (unless special circumstances cleared with Transitions House Director.)
17. Volunteer in the community (4 hours per month minimum)
18. Visitors must be substance free, stay in common areas, and leave the Transitions House by curfew. Visitors can only be in the house when Transitions House Director is present. No overnight visitors. Visitors are not allowed in student rooms.

19. Bring all concerns to the Transitions House Director who will resolve the concern or turn it over to a Transitions Board Member.
20. Within 7 days of residency, meet one-on-one with our counselor and agree to weekly sessions if they are merited.
21. Within 14 days of residency, meet one-on-one with mentor to confirm and assess academic plan.
22. Within 30 days of residency, obtain part-time employment. No more than thirty days unemployed at any given time. During the time you are seeking employment, you must volunteer Saturday at locations to be determined.
23. Schedule weekly contact with mentor to review current and future assignments.
24. Set written goals and show progress towards them; what do you want to accomplish with your life?

The Transitions Home Director is someone older than the resident who is responsible for monitoring the above. By signing this agreement, I understand that this is a zero tolerance program. If I break any of the above agreement, I understand that I may be asked to leave.

Living in the Transitions House is a privilege not open to all students. I understand I am to act as a responsible adult, and I am accountable for all my actions while residing at the Transitions House.

I also understand that I am on a two-week probation period when a final decision will be made on my residency.
